Survey and Market Research

COVID-19 Return to Work Survey

Designed an employee survey to provide organizations like E.O. Johnson and Security Health Plan with information on employees' experiences with remote work and return to work safety concerns.

Marathon County Early Years Coalition Family Friendly Workplace Study

Conducted a countywide survey of employee perceptions of "family-friendly" workplace policies and programs.

Marathon County Workplace Belonging and Inclusivity Study

Provided tools and research-driven findings to lead Marathon County forward in its workforce inclusivity efforts; conducted a survey of county employees to gather information on perceptions of belonging and inclusion.

A Feasibility Study for an Active Aging Center in Wausau, Wisconsin

Voices of Wisconsin Students Project: Learning, Coping, and Building Resilience During COVID-19

Ongoing project to conduct focus groups with students from across Wisconsin about their experiences with school and learning during COVID-19; project is a partnership of the Wisconsin Department of Health Services and the Medical College of Wisconsin.

D.C. Everest School District Student Feedback on Improving Mental Health and Wellness Resources

Ongoing project to conduct focus groups with more than 50 D.C. Everest students (elementary through high school) to help improve the district's mental health and wellness resources and support systems for students.

Open Door Outcomes Measurement Project

Developed a comprehensive Outcomes Measurement Plan, including new tools to gather and analyze data from clients.

Marshfield Clinic Health System Stakeholder Feedback Project

Gathered stakeholder input on systemwide health priorities; conducted 55 key informant interviews.
